

Children with Special Needs Policy 2022

The Elora Cooperative Preschool will make its facilities and programs available to any and all children of preschool age regardless of any special need/health care needs through accommodations within the program and/or involvement with other agencies.

Staff will need to have any additional training needed to deal with those special needs.

Parents will be highly involved in the inclusion process and the development of any necessary programming.

All individuals working with that child in the preschool or from the community services will have knowledge of any information regarding the medical condition and how best to care for the child.

These children will always remain in the group setting and will not be taken out by teachers, support staff consultants or therapists for purposes of assessment or observation.

These children will be given any and all opportunities as offered to all children in the program.
